

New Jersey Municipalities with Government Energy Aggregation Programs, July 2014

Municipalities located in the state of New Jersey may aggregate the energy requirements of residential, commercial¹ and municipal accounts in order to purchase energy from Third Party Suppliers (“TPSs”) through Government Energy Aggregation (“GEA”) Programs. The following lists detail municipalities by service territory that have enrolled customers with a TPS as a result of a completed aggregation effort.
